

Symphony Dining Group

The Symphony Dining Group maintains both a classic appeal and a transitional charm for the high-end market. The cut-out curves that nestle the gracefully tapered legs of the dining table are distinctive and sleek, and are balanced by the well-defined presence of the casegoods pieces. Negative space plays an important role in the design of this group, and what is "not there" is as important as what "is there." With careful selection of premium hardwoods and veneers (which are hand-inlaid), Symphony is targeted to the consumer with an eye for design and heirloom-quality furniture. Symphony's two distinctive pieces of hardware are custom designed by Apparenza Design Studio to complement the collection, following the inspiration of classical shapes.

Five pieces comprise the Symphony Dining Group: Dining Table, Arm and Side Chairs, Sideboard and Server. Clean lines, delicately curved legs and elegantly matched veneers highlighted with ebonized string inlays characterize this series. Flat-grain and ribbon mahogany dramatically define the planes of Symphony's various pieces, converging in expertly-matched arcs. Every line and joint is meticulously designed and executed, combining the strengths of savvy 21st century design, a knowledge of classical form and unmatched manufacturing expertise.

Following Symphony's debut at High Point in Spring 2004, the enthusiastic response prompted Polidor, our manufacturer, to expand the line to include many additional pieces for launch over the next several markets.
